US Kuwait Guantanamo

Washington, Sept 1 (BNA) His Highness Kuwait's Premier Sheikh Sabah Al Ahmad Al Jaber Al Sabah sent a letter to US President George W. Bush regarding the fate of Kuwaiti prisoners in Guantanamo detention Camp in Cuba.

Kuwait's Ambassador to the US Sheikh Salem Al-Jaber Al-Abdullah Al- Jaber Al-Sabah, who delivered the letter in a meeting with senior state department officials, told KUNA the message was about issues discussed by both leaders during the visit of H.H. the Premier to the US last July. The letter, he added, touches upon the subject that was a priority during the talks, in which H.H.the Premier underlined the necessity of resolving the issue of Kuwaiti inmates in Guantanamo. The Ambassador hoped the "letter of H.H. Sheikh Sabah Al-Ahmad would contribute to reaching a breakthrough for this issue in near future." H.H. the Prime Minister, during the visit, had discussed bilateral ties and current international affairs with President Bush and a number of senior officials.
