## **Aznar Involved In Prisoner Transfer to Guantanamo**

The former Spanish President Jose Maria Aznar has been accused of supporting the transfer of prisoners to the US military base in Guantanamo.

In their webpage, leaders of the Partido Los Verdes-SOS Naturaleza, (Green Party) -a left-wing political party from Aragon - also incriminate the Foreign Minister, Ana Palacio, and the Secretary of Defense, Federico Trillo.

According to Granma newspaper, the text is signed by the president, Rosa Burgos Perez, vice-president, Carlos Rueda Ibanez and legal secretary, Jesus Valles Gracia, of the above-mentioned organization.

The document indicates that troops from the Air Forces of Saragossa transported the prisoners from Manas (Kirghizstan) to the US military base in Guantanamo between January 2003 and March 2004.

The Spanish activists also called on the attorney's office to open an investigation into this case immediately.
